

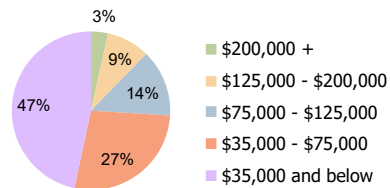

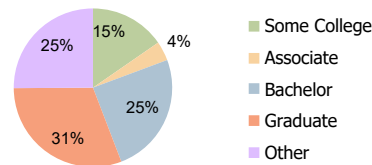

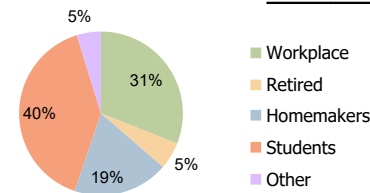

Household Income (3 Mile Radius)



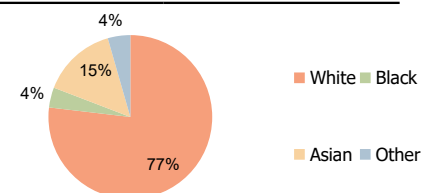
Education (3 Mile Radius)
